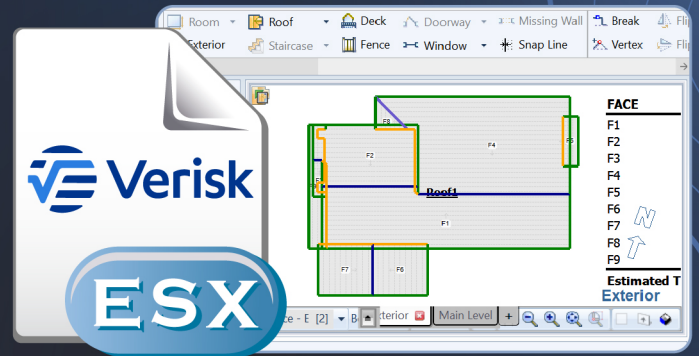




# ESX Files for Your Claims Workflow

Property adjusters can move their reports and data into Xactimate using an ESX file



## What is an ESX file?

An ESX file is digital project file that contains the measurements, 3D sketches and property photos associated with a property claim. The ESX format, which is proprietary for Xactimate, is an industry standard and accepted by many carriers.

## An Easy Way to Move Reports and Sketches into Xact

Adjusters want fast and easy workflows so they can shorten cycle times and close more claims. The ESX file lets adjusters receive Eagleview reports and sketches outside of Xact and then quickly move the information into Xact to finish the workflow.

The benefits for adjusters:

- **Efficiency:** Finish an estimate in Xact and close a claim faster
- **Less Manual Work:** Reduce hand sketching and data entry in Xact
- **Quick and Easy Import:** Using the drag and drop functionality within Xactimate
- **The Industry Standard:** Almost every carrier accepts an ESX file

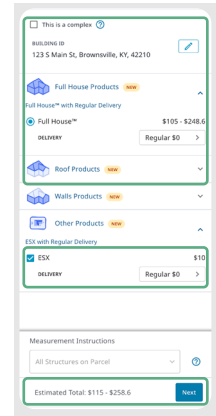

## How to order through my.eagleview.com

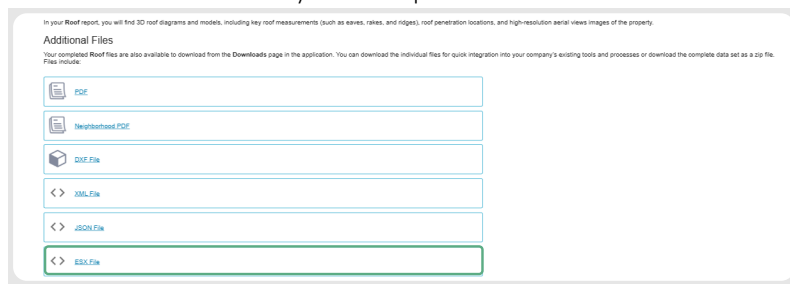
1. With a property address searched, choose your report type – Full House Report or Roof Report. Then, check the optional ESX file box.

Scroll down and hit the **Next** Button, and from the Order Summary Screen hit the **Submit Order** button.

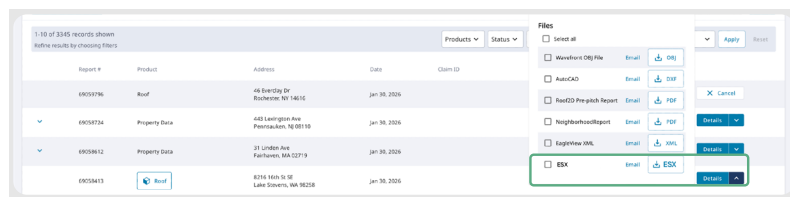


## There are 2 ways to download an ESX file

1. Open the delivery email after placing an order on myeagleview. Find the ESX file on the list and click the link. Then save the ESX file on your computer.

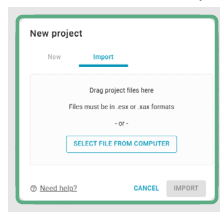


2. View the Order History on myeagleview. Hit the details button on the right next to your order and then click the download ESX button.



## How to import and use the ESX file in Xactimate

1. To bring a project into Xact, open Xact, start a new project and then drag your ESX file into the New Project window or click the Select File from Computer button.



2. The measurements and sketches from your ESX file will be viewable in Xact.
