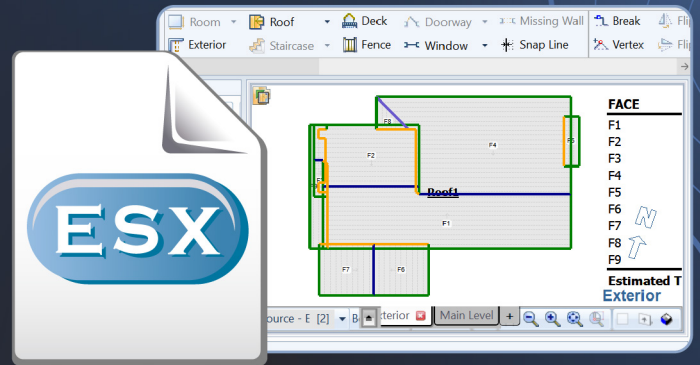

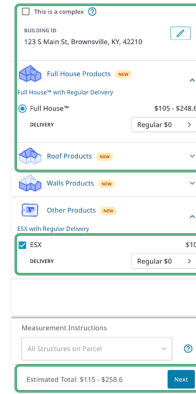

How to order through my.eagleview.com

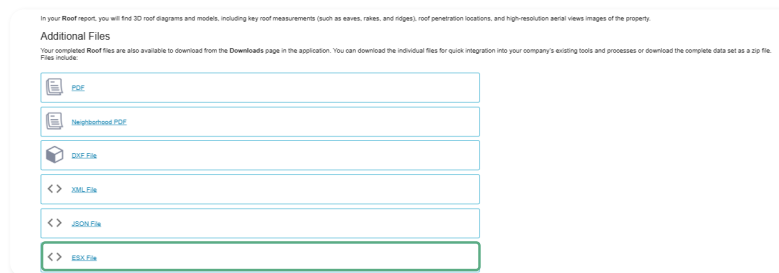
1. With a property address searched, choose your report type – Full House Report or Roof Report. Then, check the optional ESX file box.

Scroll down and hit the **Next** Button, and from the Order Summary Screen hit the **Submit Order** button.

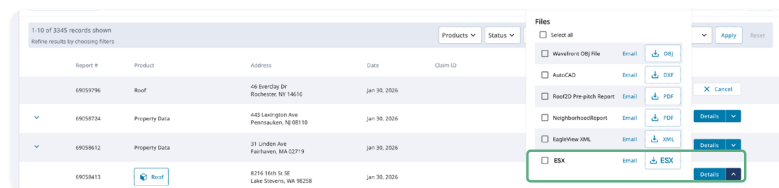


There are 2 ways to download an ESX file

1. Open the delivery email after placing an order on my.eagleview.com. Find the ESX file on the list and click the link. Then save the ESX file on your computer.

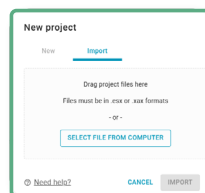


2. View the Order History on my.eagleview.com. Hit the details button on the right next to your order and then click the download ESX button.



How to import and use the ESX file in Xactimate

1. To bring a project into Xact, open Xact, start a new project and then drag your ESX file into the New Project window or click the Select File from Computer button.



2. The measurements and sketches from your ESX file will be viewable in Xact.
