Eagleview Imagery for Oriented Imagery Layers integrates our obliques into Esri products, giving users the ability to view and analyze oblique images without the need to go to another application.

OIL is supported within ArcGIS Pro, ArcGIS Online, and Experience Builder.

This product enables you to:

- Add EagleView oblique imagery to ArcGIS Pro, ArcGIS Online, and Experience Builder
- Get started quickly by providing the path to your imagery
- View and analyze oblique imagery within your GIS workflows
- Share imagery publicly or securely within your organization

Known Issues

- **[ArcGIS Online]** Occasionally imagery may not load even though a location is selected. This is rare but happens to be an issue with Esri's authentication failing. Clicking the same location again should resolve the issue, at least temporarily.
- **[ArcGIS Online]** After zooming into an image, users may be prevented from panning fully to see the whole image. Usually zooming in or out unlocks the issue as a workaround.
- **[ArcGIS Online]** Occasionally, when an image is dragged or swiped beyond the image coverage, the oriented imagery layer widget stops working. Refreshing the web browser restores functionality.
- **[All products]** When the image is loading, panning may not be smooth, or application may appear stuck. Once the image is fully loaded, this will be resolved.
- **[All products]** At some locations, when viewing the image gallery, some thumbnails images appear split into 2 images when only 1 image should appear.
